- 1. Read **Ephesians 4:1-6**. Why are the foundational truths listed in vv.4-6 important to keep in mind when it is hard to live out the commands in vv.1-3?
- 2. Read **John 17:6-11**. How does the fact that Jesus prayed for these things motivate you to make sure it is truly happening in our church? What can you do to elevate these intentions of Christ as a priority in your life?
- 3. Read **John 17:20-23**. Why do you think a strong, well-cared-for, highly committed, unified congregation has the effect on the world that Jesus spoke of in this text?
- 4. Read **Philippians 1:8**; **4:1** and **1 Thessalonians 2:8**. What would change about your relationship with our church if your heart was more like the Apostle Paul's? What is keeping you from feeling more like this toward your fellow congregants at Compass?
- 5. Read **Philippians 2:17**. What are the main action steps you are taking away from this series in Acts 20? What has changed or is changing about your view of leading and serving others in the body of Christ?
