- I. PAUL, *THE AMBASSADOR TO ROME IN CHAINS*, WRITES TO THE CHRISTIANS AT EPHESUS ABOUT THE SPIRITUAL WARFARE IN WHICH HE HAS NOW BEEN ENGAGED FOR ABOUT 35 YEARS (C. 33-68 A.D.).
- II. BETWEEN THE YEARS 50-70 A.D. PAUL MINISTERS TO THE EPHESIANS

A. Arrives with Priscilla and Aquila (Acts 18:18)-52 A.D.
B. Lived in Ephesus for about 3 years (Acts 19:10)-55 A.D.
C. Paul's touching farewell to the Ephesians-(Acts 20:18-28)
D. Paul becomes a prisoner of Rome (Acts 28:31, 61 A.D., 63 A.D.)
E. Helped in Rome by Onesiphorus from Ephesus (2 Tim. 1:16-18); wants Timothy to come from Ephesus to Rome (2 Tim. 4:9) and sends Tychicus to Ephesus to help the Ephesians (2 Tim. 4:12)
F. Paul was beheaded by Nero (54-68)-date of Paul's death is uncertain
