God's Call For His People To Be A Treasured Possession Requires Testing To Prove Genuineness, (vs. 1 - 20)

<u>God's Testing Disciplines His Children With Seasons Of Abundance To Teach Stewardship, (vs. 5 – 10)</u>
We must accept the goodness of God as His provision which leads us to living in faithfulness, (vs. 8)

8.1) God's Goodness Provides For Daily Necessities

"Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit. Whoever loves his life loses it, and whoever hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. If anyone serves me, he must follow me; and where I am, there will my servant be also. If anyone serves me, the Father will honor him." (John 12:24–26, ESV)

8.2) God's Goodness Provides For Security & Protection

"but they shall sit every man under his vine and under his fig tree, and no one shall make them afraid, for the mouth of the LORD of hosts has spoken. For all the peoples walk each in the name of its god, but we will walk in the name of the LORD our God forever and ever." (Micah 4:4–5, ESV)

8.3) God's Goodness Provides For Prosperity & Health

"Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working." (James 5:14–16, ESV)

8.4) God's Goodness Provides For Abundance

More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb. Moreover, by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward." (Psalm 19:9–11, ESV)
