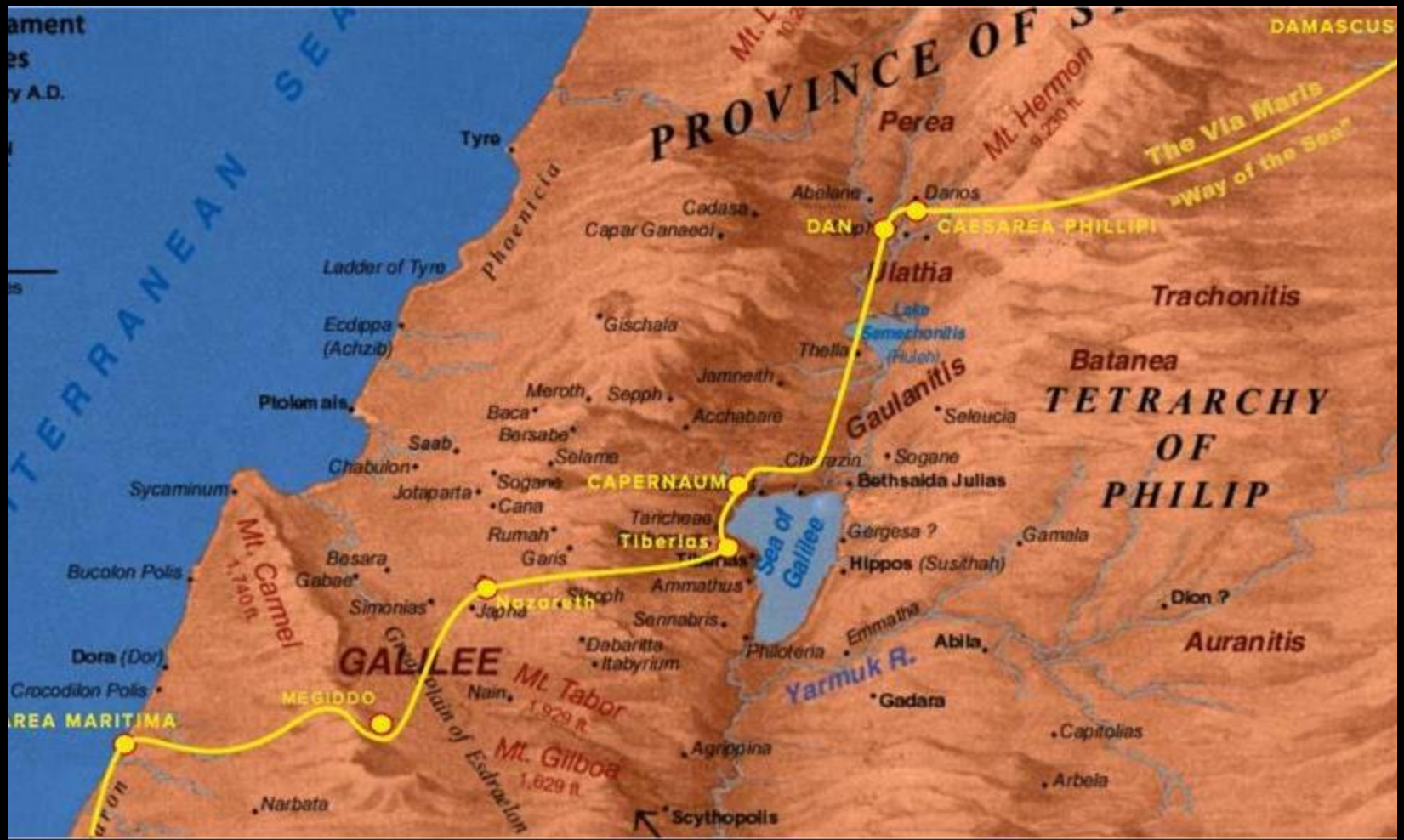


Map of Ancient Galilee
