II. <u>Our Forgiveness</u>

- A. It is only by God Isaiah 43:25; 44:22
- B. God forgives through the mediation of Jesus Christ... Acts 13:38; 4:12; Colossians 1:14

C. There must be Repentance and Faith...

- 1. Repentance "begins" with confession... I John 1:8-9
- 2. It is necessary *Psalm* 7:12; *Luke* 5:31-32 cf. 13:3, 5; Acts 2:38; 3: 19; *II Corinthians* 7:9ff
- 3. Faith is belief... Acts 26:20; John 3:14, 17; Romans 10:9

Observations: 1. When a person truly believes in Jesus, he is immediately justified and his sins (past, present and future) are forgiven and Christ's righteousness is imputed to him... John 5:24; Romans 8:1 2. However, because of our "old man" and sin remaining we are still to pray daily for forgiveness... Ephesians 4:22 cf. I John 1:8
