6th sermon: THE DANGER OF ANGER

Text: Psalm 39

Theme: Holding your anger inside of you is still sin.

There are two Greek words for anger

Thumos – quickly boil and soon subside

Orge – subtle temper used to inflict punishment

I. Don't let your "good" be evil spoken of (v. 1)

Prov 10:19 In the multitude of words there wanteth not sin: but he that **refraineth** his lips *is* wise.

17:27 He that hath knowledge **spareth** his words: *and* a man of understanding is of an excellent spirit.

28 Even a fool, when he holdeth his peace, is counted wise...

29:11 A fool uttereth all his mind: but a wise *man* keepeth it in till afterwards.

II. Don't let your silence lead to the subtilty of sin (vv. 2, 3)

Anger is a strong emotion that often leads to a sinful response

Anger is a result of passion. You don't get angry about something you don't care about
