 - Gen. 2:17 Rom. 5:12-21 6:23a Gal. 3:10 all speak about *death*

THE TRUTH ABOUT DEATH

I. It is deserved separation II. It is eternal reality

I. THE TRUTH ABOUT DEATH: DESERVED SEPARATION

- A. Death is not the end of life or existence
 - 1. God established a relationship with us (Gen. 2:16-17)
 - 2. Gen. 3:6 informs us how this spiritual relationship ended
 - a. Adam committed spiritual adultery
 - b. The effect was instant: Gen. 3:7-8, 10
 - 3. Through this separation from God, we lost everything beautiful!
- B. This separation is well deserved (Rom. 6:23)
 - 1. Adam knew full well what was coming (Gen. 2:17)
 - 2. Therefore remind yourself daily that we experience what we deserve
 - a. we were able to resist Satan's temptation
 - b. there was no need to be dissatisfied with the portion God gave us
- C. This separation did not only affect us as mankind (Gen. 3:8, 11)

II. THE TRUTH ABOUT DEATH: DEATH IS ETERNAL

- A. How do we define eternal?
 - 1. The 'time-line' definition vs. the 'size-line' definition
 - 2. Both eternal death and eternal life are everlasting journeys
 - a. Gen. 4:16 vs Eph. 2:7
 - 3. We need to learn to think in a God-honouring way about eternal hell
 - a. hell is place of God's ultimate revelation of wrath & displeasure
 - Rom. 1:18-32 & 2 Thess. 1:8-9
 - b. hell is an increasing journey of desolation
 - Rev. 9:6 and 18:22-23
- B. In this life we experience initial phase of this spiritual separation from God
 - 1. We are born as children of wrath (Eph. 2:3)
 - a. this explains the reason why we are what we are (Rom. 3:10-18)
 - b. this explains the reason for Gen. 6:11-12

TAKE ALONG ...

- A. God's anger is the *jealousy and pain of His love*
- B. God is grieved with what He sees in our world and heart (Gen. 6:5-6)
 - a. He swears that He has not pleasure in our death (Ezek. 33:11)
 - b. He reveals He is ready to pardon to start again (Is. 55:7-9)
 - c. Each day we live in rebellion shows His long-suffering (2 Peter 3:9)
- C. God is calling you today to return to Him (Is. 1:18)
