**TEXT: Mark 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.**

**Matthew 9:27** And when Jesus departed thence, **two blind men followed him, crying**, and saying, Thou Son of David, have mercy on us.

28 And when he was come into the house, the **blind men came** to him: **and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord.**

29 Then touched he their eyes, saying, **According to your faith be it unto you.**

30 And their eyes were opened...

Hebrews 6:12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who **through faith and patience** inherit the promises.

Hebrews 11:6 But **without faith**  
it is impossible to please him: for  
he that cometh to God must  
**believe that he is, and that he is**  
**a rewarder of them that**  
**diligently seek him.**

"...and Jesus saith unto them,  
**Believe ye** that I am able to do this?  
They said unto him, Yea, Lord.  
Then touched he their eyes, saying,  
**According to your faith be it unto  
you."**

Isaiah 62:6 I have set watchmen upon thy walls, O Jerusalem, which **shall never hold their peace day nor night:** ye that make mention of the LORD, **keep not silence,**  
7 And **give him no rest, till** he establish, and till he make Jerusalem a praise in the earth.

**Exodus 3:9 Now**

**therefore, behold, the**

**cry of the children of**

**Israel is come unto me...**

1 Samuel 9:16...for I have  
looked upon my people,  
because **their cry is come unto  
me.**

**Psalms 88:1 O LORD God of my salvation, I have cried day and night before thee:**

**2 Let my prayer come before thee: incline thine ear unto my cry;**

**3 For my soul is full of troubles...**

**9...I have called daily upon thee, I have stretched out my hands unto thee.**

**Psalms 102:1 Hear my  
prayer, O LORD, and let  
my cry come unto thee.**

**Mark 4:38** And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, **carest thou not that we perish?**

**39** And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

**40** And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? **how is it that ye have no faith?**

**Matthew 8:24 And, behold, there arose a great tempest in the sea, insomuch that the ship was covered with the waves: but he was asleep.**

**25 And his disciples came to him, and awoke him, saying, Lord, save us: we perish.**

**26 And he saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, **O ye of little faith?** Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm.**

Luke 18:1 And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that **men ought always to pray, and not to faint;**

2 Saying, There was in a city a judge, which feared not God, neither regarded man:

3 And there was a widow in that city; and **she came unto him**, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary.

4 And **he would not for a while:** but afterward he said within himself, Though I fear not God, nor regard man;

5 Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her **continual coming** she weary me.

6 And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge saith.

7 And shall not God avenge his own elect, which **cry day and night** unto him, though he **bear long** with them?

8 I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless **when the Son of man cometh,** shall he find **faith** on the earth?

Matthew 15:22 And, behold, a woman of Canaan **came out** of the same coasts, **and cried unto him**, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, thou Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil.

23 But **he answered her not a word**. And his disciples came and besought him, saying, Send her away; **for she crieth after us**.

24 But **he answered and said**, I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

**Matthew 15:25** Then  
**came she** and  
worshipped him, saying,  
**Lord, help me.**

**Matthew 15:26** But he answered and said, It is not meet to take **the children's bread**, and to **cast it to dogs**.

Matthew 15:27 And she  
said, **Truth, Lord:** yet the  
dogs eat of **the crumbs**  
which fall from their  
masters' table.

**Matthew 15:28 Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.**

Hebrews 11:6 But without faith  
it is impossible to please him: for  
he that **cometh to God** must  
**believe that he is,** and that he is  
a **rewarder of them that**  
**diligently** seek him.

Galatians 3:7 Know ye therefore that they which are of **faith, the same are the children of Abraham.**

8 And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify **the heathen** through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed.

**26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.**

**Matthew 7:8** For every one that **asketh** receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

**9** Or what man is there of you, whom **if his son ask bread**, will he give him a stone?

**10** Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent?

**11** If ye then, being evil, know **how to give good gifts unto your children**, how much more shall **your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?**

1 John 5:14 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, **if we ask any thing according to his will**, he heareth us:

15 And if we know that he hear us, **whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.**

1 John 3:21 Beloved, if our heart  
condemn us not, **then have we  
confidence** toward God.

22 And **whatsoever we ask, we receive of  
him, because we keep his  
commandments,** and do those things  
that are pleasing in his sight.

**Matthew 9:29...According  
to your faith be it unto  
you.**

Philippians 1:12 But I would ye  
should understand, brethren,  
that **the things which happened**  
**unto me have fallen out rather**  
**unto the furtherance of the**  
**gospel;**

Philippians 4:11 Not that I  
speak in respect of want: for I  
have learned, **in whatsoever  
state I am**, therewith to be  
content.

Philippians 1:19 For I know that **this shall turn to my salvation through your prayer,** and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ,  
24 Nevertheless **to abide in the flesh is more needful for you.**

25 And having this confidence, I know that **I shall abide and continue with you all** for your furtherance and joy of faith;

Philippians 2:23 Him therefore I  
hope to send presently, **so soon as I  
shall see how it will go with me.**

24 But **I trust** in the Lord that **I also  
myself shall come shortly.**

**...to abide in the flesh  
is more needful for  
you.**

**John 11:11...Our friend Lazarus sleepeth;  
but I go, **that I may awake him** out of sleep.**

**14 Then said Jesus unto them plainly,  
Lazarus is dead.**

**15...let us go unto him.**

**16 Then said Thomas, which is called  
Didymus, unto his fellowdisciples, **Let us also  
go, that we may die with him.****

**Psalms 27:12 Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty.**

**13 I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.**

**14 Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.**

Isaiah 38:10 I said in the cutting off of my days, I shall go to the gates of the **grave...**

11 I said, I shall not see the LORD, even the LORD, **in the land of the living:** I shall behold man no more with the inhabitants of the world.

**Matthew 14:28** And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water.

**29** And **he said, Come.** And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.

**30** But **when he saw the wind** boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.

**31** And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, **O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?**

**Matthew 13:57** And they were offended in him. But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, save in his own country, and in his own house.

**58** And **he did not many mighty works there because of their unbelief.**

1 Corinthians 7:21 Art thou  
called being a servant? **care**  
**not for it: but if thou mayest**  
**be made free, use it rather.**

**Mark 2:2** And straightway many were gathered together, insomuch that there was no room to receive them, no, not so much as about the door: and he preached the word unto them.

**3** And **they come unto him**, bringing one sick of the palsy, which was borne of four.

**4** And **when they could not come nigh unto him** for the press, they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they had broken it up, they let down the bed wherein the sick of the palsy lay.

**5** **When Jesus saw their faith**, he said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee.
