- 1. Fighting the good fight of faith requires that believers and churches have a commitment to prayer.
  - a. \_\_\_\_\_ and petitions are to be made on behalf of men of all sorts.
  - b. The giving of \_\_\_\_\_\_ to God should be a regular part of the believer's life.
- 2. Fighting the good fight of faith calls believers and churches to regularly pray for kings and all in authority.
