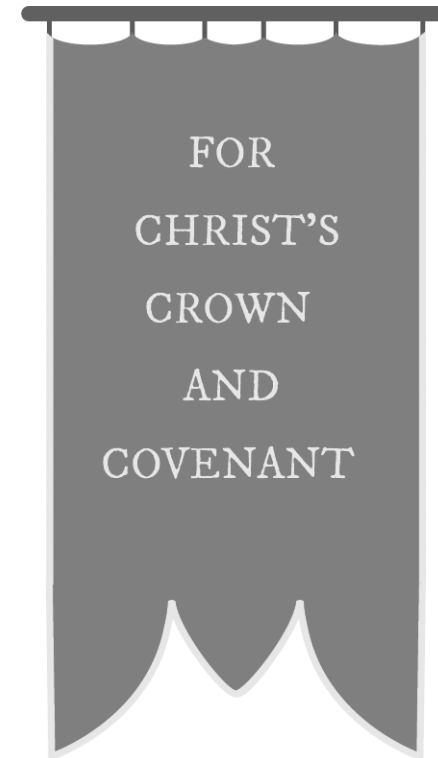

**LARGER CATECHISM Q. 138:** *What are the duties required in the seventh commandment?*
