## QUESTION # 113: WHAT ARE THE SINS FORBIDDEN IN THE THIRD COMMANDMENT?

### ANSWER:

THE SINS FORBIDDEN IN THE THIRD COMMANDMENT ARE, THE NOT USING OF GOD'S NAME AS IS REQUIRED;<sup>A</sup> AND THE ABUSE OF IT IN AN IGNORANT,<sup>B</sup> VAIN,<sup>C</sup> IRREVERENT, PROFANE,<sup>D</sup> SUPERSTITIOUS,<sup>E</sup> OR WICKED MENTIONING, OR OTHERWISE USING HIS TITLES, ATTRIBUTES,<sup>F</sup> ORDINANCES,<sup>G</sup> OR WORKS,<sup>H</sup> BY BLASPHEMY,<sup>I</sup> PERJURY;<sup>J</sup> ALL SINFUL CURSINGS,<sup>K</sup> OATHS,<sup>L</sup> VOWS,<sup>M</sup> AND LOTS;<sup>N</sup> VIOLATING OF OUR OATHS AND VOWS, IF LAWFUL;<sup>O</sup> AND FULFILLING THEM, IF OF THINGS UNLAWFUL;<sup>P</sup> MURMURING AND QUARRELING AT,<sup>Q</sup> CURIOUS PRYING INTO,<sup>R</sup> AND MISAPPLYING OF GOD'S DECREES<sup>S</sup> AND PROVIDENCES;<sup>T</sup> MISINTERPRETING,<sup>U</sup> MISAPPLYING,<sup>V</sup> OR ANY WAY PERVERTING THE WORD, OR ANY PART OF IT,<sup>W</sup> TO PROFANE JESTS,<sup>X</sup> CURIOUS OR UNPROFITABLE QUESTIONS, VAIN JANGLINGS, OR THE MAINTAINING OF FALSE DOCTRINES;<sup>Y</sup> ABUSING IT, THE CREATURES, OR ANY THING CONTAINED UNDER THE NAME OF GOD, TO CHARMS,<sup>Z</sup> OR SINFUL LUSTS AND PRACTICES;<sup>A</sup> THE MALIGNING,<sup>B</sup> SCORNING,<sup>C</sup> REVILING,<sup>D</sup> OR ANY WISE OPPOSING OF GOD'S TRUTH, GRACE, AND WAYS;<sup>E</sup> MAKING PROFESSION OF RELIGION IN HYPOCRISY, OR FOR SINISTER ENDS;<sup>F</sup> BEING ASHAMED OF IT,<sup>G</sup> OR A SHAME TO IT, BY UNCONFORMABLE,<sup>H</sup> UNWISE,<sup>I</sup> UNFRUITFUL,<sup>J</sup> AND OFFENSIVE WALKING,<sup>K</sup> OR BACKSLIDING FROM IT.<sup>L</sup>
