Titus 1:5 appoint elders in every city as I directed you, 7 For the overseer must be above reproach ...
Acts 20:17...Paul... called to him the elders of the church. 28 Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.
1 Pet. 5:1 Therefore, I exhort the elders among you... 2 shepherd the flock of God among you, exercising oversight

2nd - Unusual

Acts 15:2 Paul and Barnabas ...should go up to Jerusalem to the apostles and elders concerning this issue. Acts 15:22 Then it seemed good to the apostles and the elders, with the whole church, Acts 16:4 decided upon by the apostles and elders Acts 21:18 And now the following day Paul went in with us to James, and all the elders were present.

Acts 14:23 And when they had appointed elders for them in every church, having prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord in whom they had believed.

Titus 3:13 Diligently help Zenas the lawyer and Apollos on their way so that nothing is lacking for them. Titus 3:12 When I send Artemas or Tychicus to you, make every effort to come to me at Nicopolis, for I have decided to spend the winter there.

In preparation for the Lord's Table

Read 1 Corinthians 11:17-34 and ask the following questions

1. Am I a true Christian? 2 Corinthians 13:5 *Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith; examine yourselves! Or do you not recognize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you- unless indeed you fail the test?*

2. Am I living by the Word of God in submission to the Holy Spirit? Galatians 5:16 But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.

3. Am I currently in right relationship with others?

Matthew 5:23-24 If therefore you are presenting your offering at the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your offering there before the altar, and go your way; first be reconciled to your brother, and then come and present your offering.

4. Have I confessed all known sin of commission (doing what the Bible says not to do) and all sins of omission (not doing what the Bible commands to do)? Ephesians 4:30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. I Thessalonians 5:19: Do not quench the Spirit;

5. Am I remembering the cost Jesus paid for my salvation?

1 Corinthians 11:24 and when He had given thanks, He broke it, and said, "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me."

6. Parents, are the above questions true of your children so that they may partake without judgment? 1 Corinthians 11:27-28 *Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup.*
