(Does God View the Church as Essential? Do You?)

Jesus Christ said emphatically in Matthew 16:18

#1: The local church according to God's blueprint is very important and vital for the saints to be (Acts 2:41-42) What were they intensely and
repeatedly devoted to on a regular basis?
• Focus 1 - "the apostle"" - this is first on the list because of its priority, for apart from a steady diet of sound & systematic scriptural teaching regarding Jesus Christ, the Gospel, etc. there will be no true worship or spiritual growth. In addition, the remaining elements in this verse will be misunderstood or simply legalistically followed. This is a necessary element to worship the Lord "in spirit and in truth".
• Focus 2 – "" – this "koinonia" is derived from a developing like-mindedness around the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the Word of God resulting in spiritual conversation and participation.
• Focus 3 – "in the breaking of bread" or the – this celebration was reflective of the Gospel and was to be done "in remembrance" of their Savior and Lord and with thanks for His finished work.
• Focus 4 – "" – this involved group or corporate prayers uttered from needy and thankful hearts in response to the Word of God with praise, supplication, and intercession.
• What about corporate singing in worship? Is "worship" really that important to the Lord? (John 4:23-24)
