Blessings are found in:

I. Interdependence – “by the hand of Ithamar” (38:21-23)

We bless others by our:

A. Submission – “according to the commandment of Moses”

B. Service - “for the service of the Levites”

C. Style – “an engraver, and a cunning workman”

II. Investment – “gold that was occupied for the work” (v. 24-31)

We bless others by being:

A. Personal - “A bekah for every man”

B. Powerful – “for 603, 550 men”

C. Purposeful – “a talent for a socket”

III. Integrity – “behold they had done it” (39:32, 42-43)

We bless others through:

A. Accomplishment – “the tent of the congregation finished”

B. Adherence – “did according to all the Lord commanded”

C. Accountability – “Moses did look upon all the work”
