TEXT: 1 Corinthians 7:12 But to the rest speak I, not the Lord: If any brother hath a wife that believeth not, and she be **pleased to dwell with him**, let him not put her away.

13 And the woman which hath an husband that believeth not, and **if he be pleased to dwell with her**, let her not leave him.

15 But if the unbelieving depart, let him depart. A brother or a sister is not under bondage in such cases: **but God hath called us to peace.**

1 Corinthians 7:33 But he that is married careth for the things that are of the world, **how he may please his wife.**

34 There is difference also between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit: but she that is married careth for the things of the world, **how she may please her husband.**

Exodus 21:8 If **she please not** her master, who hath **betrothed** her to himself, then shall he let her be redeemed: to sell her unto a strange nation he shall have no power, seeing he hath dealt deceitfully with her.

Genesis 30:20 And Leah said, God hath endued me with a good dowry; **now will my husband dwell with me**, because I have born him six sons: and she called his name Zebulun.

Deuteronomy 24:1 When a man hath taken a wife, and married her, and it come to pass that **she find no favour in his eyes**, because he hath found some uncleanness in her: then let him write her a bill of divorcement, and give it in her hand, and send her out of his house.

2 And when she is departed out of his house, she may go and be another man's wife.

3 And if the latter husband hate her,
and write her a bill of divorcement,
and giveth it in her hand, and
sendeth her out of his house; or if
the latter husband die, which took
her to be his wife;

Romans 15:1 We then that are strong ought to bear the infirmities of the weak, and not to please ourselves.

2 Let every one of us please his neighbour for his good to edification.

Judges 14:3 Then his father and his mother said unto him, Is there never a woman among the daughters of thy brethren, or among all my people, that thou goest to take a wife of the uncircumcised Philistines? And Samson said unto his father, Get her for me; **for she pleaseth me well.**

Esther 2:4 And let the maiden
which pleaseth the king be queen
instead of Vashti. And the thing
pleased the king; and he did so.

Proverbs 7:10 And, behold, there met him a woman with the attire of an harlot, and subtil of heart.

11 (She is loud and stubborn; her feet abide not in her house:

12 Now is she without, now in the streets, and lieth in wait at every corner.)

Genesis 18:9 And they said
unto him, Where is Sarah
thy wife? And he said,
Behold, in the tent.

Titus 2:4 That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,

5 To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

1 Timothy 5:11 But the younger widows refuse...

13 And withal they learn to be idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not.

14 I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house...
