“I was glad when they said unto me, let us go into the house of the Lord” (Ps. 122:1)..

**2. If the church is a family it should be a place of \_\_\_\_\_.**

“Let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as we see the day approaching” (Heb.10:24-25).

- We are to “depend on one another” (Rom. 12:5);
- We are to “be devoted to one another” (Rom. 12: 10);
- We are to “honor one another” (Rom. 12:10);
- We are to “rejoice with one another” (Rom. 12:15; 1 Cor. 12:26);
- We are to “weep with one another” (Rom. 12:15);
- We are to “be of the same mind toward one another” (Rom. 12:16);
- We are not to judge one another” (Rom. 14:13);
- We are to “accept one another” (Rom. 15:7);
- We are to “admonish one another” (Rom. 15:14);
- We are to “salute one another” (Rom. 16:16);
- We are to “wait for one another” (I Cor. 11:33);
- We are to “care for one another” (I Cor. 12:25);
- We are to “serve one another” (Gal. 5:13);
- We are to “be kind one to another” (Eph. 4:32);
- We are to “forgive one another” (Eph. 4:32; Col. 3:13);
- We are to “be tenderhearted toward one another” (Eph. 4:32);
- We are to “encourage one another” (I Thes. 5: 11);
- We are to “submit to one another” (Eph. 5:21);
- We are to “forbear (uphold) one another” (Eph. 4:2; Col. 3:13);
- We are to “provoke (stimulate) one another” (Heb. 10:24);
- We are to “show hospitality one to another” (I Peter 4:9);
- We are to “minister gifts one to another” (I Peter 4:10);
- We are to “be humble one toward another” (I Peter 5:5);
- We are not to speak evil against one another” (James 4: 11);
- We are “not to grumble against one another” (James 5:9);
- We are to “confess our faults one to another” (James 5:16);
- We are to “pray one for another” (James 5:16);
- We are to “fellowship with one another” (I John 1:7);
- We are “not to be puffed up against one another” (I Cor. 4:6);
- We are “to bear one another’s burdens” (Gal. 6:2).
