8. When this important aspect of life returns, what will be the effect on the people (vv. 17-18)?
9. How long will this state of affairs last (v. 17b)?
10. Describe the contrast between those who rely on their own strength and wisdom and those who trust the LORD (vv. 19-20)?
11. What central feature of the New Covenant is vitally connected with the proclamation of the Gospel?
12. Is it legitimate to talk about the "renewal" of the world in light of all of the death, destruction, and evil that continues in this life?
13. How does God's program of renewal and transformation work?
14. What does it mean that you are a "new creation" in Christ through faith in Him and that all things are (becoming) new?
15. How are you a player in the transformation of the world?
