God's Everlasting Faithfulness (Psalm 105)

- Psalm 105 & 106 are strikingly similar as we draw to the end of book 4
- Psalm 105: God's faithfulness to Israel: Abraham to the promise land
- Psalm 106: Israel's unfaithfulness to God during over the same period
- First 15 vss of Ps 105 & last two vss of Ps 106 / Ps 96: 1 Chron 16:8-36

I. Bless the God of Abraham (vv.1-6)

- Vs 1-5 challenges us to 'remember' what God has done for His people

 II. God's Covenant (vv.7-11)
- The theme of Ps 105 is seen in stanza 2: God's covenant with Abraham III. God's Early Faithfulness with Israel (vv.12-15)
- God chose Israel because of His love and not because they were special IV. Israel in Egypt: Joseph (vv.16-23)
- God delivered Joseph: he died trusting God & His covenant faithfulness

V. Israel Out of Egypt: The Exodus (vv.24-36)

- 1. The great darkness (v. 28; Exodus 10:21–29)
- 2. The Nile turned to blood (v. 29; Exodus 7:14–24)
- 3. The land overrun with frogs (v. 30; Exodus 8:1–15)
- 4. <u>The plague of flies</u> (v. 31; Exodus. 8:20–32)
- 5. <u>Dust turned to gnats</u> (v. 31; Exodus 8:16–19)
- 6. Thunder, hail, and lightning (vv. 32–33; Exodus 9:13–35)
- 7. <u>The plague of locusts</u> (vv. 34–35; Exodus 10:1–20)
- 8. The death of the firstborn (v. 36; Exodus 11:1–12:30)

VI. Through the Wilderness to Canaan (vv.37-45)

- Vs 42 For He remembered His holy promise, & Abraham His servant
- God's faithfulness & love should lead us to live a holy & pleasing life
