## Job 13:15

**15 Though he slay me, yet will I trust in him: but I will maintain mine own ways before him. (KJV)**

Who among us hasn't passed through difficult times? Now, here is the bottom line, if we are going to be the people that God wants us to be, we must learn how to handle life's valleys, trials, and problems. The book of Job has something to say about handling the difficult situations of life.

The message taught in this book can give us the faith to echo the words of Job, "Though He slay me, yet will I trust in Him."

{Sentence connector , It's a conjunction}

**I've been thinking about the word "yet" this morning.**

Officially, the word **"yet"** has a few different uses/definitions, but for the sake of this MESSAGE I want to focus on the following meaning of the word:

"Sentence connector-nevertheless, still, in spite of that"-

Though **is** fine conjunction. It's no "but" or "however", though it **is** a useful word, when you want let a reader know that two ideas **are** opposing one another. ... The word Though at the beginning tells us to look for that comma.

---

**"Yet"** usually connects something negative with something positive, something painful with something comforting;

**"Yet"** often brings together in one thought or sentence both the dark clouds and the silver lining-

**“Yet”** can be a POWERFUL word of hope and encouragement!

- “I have many lemons right now, yet I am learning to make lemonade!”
- “My right hand is broken, yet I am beginning to write with my left hand!”
- I’d like to buy the shoes, yet to be honest I don’t need them.
- “Life is bringing me to my knees, yet from here I can more clearly see God’s footprints with me!”

I want to show just a few of the ways that God uses this word **“yet”** to encourage us, to give us endurance and hope, to contrast the seeming hopelessness of our situations with the true hopefulness of His love, His power, His faithfulness, and His willingness to show that we can, no matter what we are going through.
