God's Will Regarding Divorce

- I. Prohibited From the Beginning.A. Jesus expresses God's will regarding divorce simply: "from the beginning it was not so."
 - B. If this was God's will from the beginning, what about the law of Moses?
- II. Promoting Life-Long Marriages.
 - A. God's will regarding divorce is positive in its purpose: to promote life-long marriages.
 - B. This promotion of life long marriage also serves as the basis for Jesus' words in the text, denouncing the remarriage of divorced persons as adultery.
- III. Providing One Exception.
 - A. God states one exception to His will regarding divorce: "except for fornication."
 - B. This exception regards the reason for divorce only, and does not permit those who are divorced because of fornication to remarry.
