Discussion Questions

The following questions are designed to be used by parents in discussing the sermon with their children, but can be used by anyone in discussing the sermon with others:

1. What stood out to you in this sermon? Why?
2. Who were Simon, Andrew, James, and John? What were they doing when Christ called them?
3. What did Christ call these men to do?
4. Does Christ ask or command us to follow Him? What does this tell us about Christ?
5. Is every true Christian a disciple of Christ? What does it mean to be a disciple of Christ?
6. How does someone become a fisher of men? How are Christians to go about fishing for men?

Going Deeper:

These questions are designed for the believer to use in prayer with his/her Lord, and in discussion with brothers and sisters in the Lord:

1. What does it mean to leave everything and follow Jesus Christ?
2. What have you given up for the sake of Christ and the gospel?
3. What difference does it make in your daily decisions that you are a follower of Christ? How evident is it to the unbelievers you know that you are a follower of Christ?
4. Is every Christian called to be a fisher of men? Use Scripture to support your answer.
5. How have you been involved in fishing for men in recent months?
6. How should you apply this passage to your life this week?
