
Coming out of the Enlightenment was the philosophical framework called **rationalism**.

By definition rationalism is “the principle or practice of accepting reason as the **only** authority in determining one’s opinions or course of action.”




Biography

- Born May 17, 1844 at Hameln on Weser, Westphalia, Germany
- Studied theology at the University of Gottingen under Ewald.
- Became a professor of theology at Greifswald in 1872.
- Resigned under pressure in 1882 for his rationalistic views.




- Became professor of oriental languages at Halle, Marburg in 1885, and in 1892 returned to Gottingen where he remained until his death.
- Authored a number of works in German.
- His influence upon European theology was absolutely profound.



Documentary Theory


"Scholars who will not admit divine revelation seek to explain Old Testament belief in God in terms of evolution. They would have Old Testament monotheism be the resultant from lower stages, or from polytheism, or regard it as a peculiar instinct of the Semites, or as borrowed from neighboring nations." 
Wellhausen was a German rationalist. He wanted to **demythologize** the Bible.

He regarded the Bible as a sublime collection of **human** documents.

He taught that religion was a process of **evolution** from the worship of many gods to monotheism.



Since science was the answer to all things, Wellhausen applied a scientific approach to analyzing Scripture which resulted in his infamous Documentary Theory.




Documentary Theory

 E – Elohim writer


 D – Deuteronomy writer

 P – Priestly writer




The Philosophy of Liberalism

- As his ideas evolved, so did his idea of God. God is no longer the God of judgment but now He is the God of love.



- ➌ The pursuit of this program of enlightenment will save mankind. Man will save himself.






Higher Criticism


Higher Criticism

- Destroys the Literary Unity of the Bible




- Undermines the Bible's Textual Authority
