Westminster Shorter Catechism

**THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE
LORD'S SUPPER**

Q. 171. How are they who receive the
Sacrament of the Lord's Supper to
prepare themselves before they come unto it?

A. They that receive the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper are, before they come, to prepare themselves thereunto.

They have to examine themselves whether they are in Christ and thus of their sins and wants; of the truth and measure of their knowledge, faith, and repentance; of their love to God and their fellow

**brothers and sisters and their charity
to all men, forgiving all those that have
done them wrong.**

**Finally, of their desires after Christ, and of
their new obedience; and by renewing the
exercise of these graces,
by serious meditation, and fervent prayer.**
