Further Considerations

Joshua 6:1-5

What was the response in Jericho to Israel's entering the land? (See also Joshua 5:1.) What are some methods of ancient warfare for defeating a fortified city? What does verse 2 indicate about the outcome of the battle? How can this truth encourage you in battles you face?

Joshua 6:6-19

How were the people to behave as they marched around the city? How do you think the people of Jericho responded to this sight as the days continued? What might the soldiers have thought as they saw the size of the walls of Jericho? What is the significance of the presence of the Ark of the Covenant as Israel marched around Jericho? What does the Ark represent? What does this method of "warfare" reveal about the battle and the victory? What are some other Biblical examples of God using unlikely or "impossible" methods to accomplish His purpose? Why is it important to keep your eyes on the Lord when facing seemingly insurmountable situations?

Joshua 6:20-27

How does Rahab's response to Israel's coming differ from the response of the rest of Jericho? What does this reveal about God's grace? Read Genesis 15:13-16. Why did God not give Abram the land immediately? What does this indicate about God's judgment at the time of Joshua? Read 2 Peter 3:9. What is the purpose of God's patience? In what ways has God been patient with you? How should the realization of God's judgment encourage you to share the Gospel with others?
