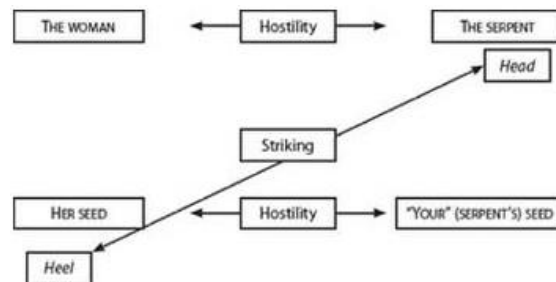
Introduction: Luke 22:41-44

And [Jesus] withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed, ⁴² saying, "Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me. Nevertheless, not my will, but yours, be done." ⁴³ And there appeared to him an angel from heaven, strengthening him. ⁴⁴ And being in an agony he prayed more earnestly; and his sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

1. Isaiah 52:13—53:12
 - a. Check some bits from it:
Behold, **my servant** shall act wisely; he shall be high and lifted up, and shall be exalted. ...**53:4** Surely **he** has **borne our griefs** and **carried our sorrows**; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. ⁵ But he was **pierced** for **our transgressions**; he was **crushed** for **our iniquities**; **upon him** was the **chastisement** that brought us **peace**, and with **his wounds** we are **healed**. ⁶ All we like **sheep** have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the LORD has **laid on him** the **iniquity** of us all. ⁸ ...**he was cut off out of the land of the living**, stricken for the **transgression** of my **people**? ⁹ And they made his **grave** with the **wicked** and with a **rich** man in his **death**, although he had done no violence, and there was no deceit in his mouth. ¹⁰ Yet it was the **will** of the LORD to **crush** him; he has put him to grief; when **his soul makes an offering for guilt**, he shall **see his offspring**; he shall **prolong his days**; the will of the LORD shall **prosper** in his hand. ¹¹ Out of the anguish of his soul he shall see and be satisfied; by his knowledge shall the righteous one, my servant, make many to be accounted righteous, and he shall bear their iniquities. ¹² Therefore I will divide him a **portion** with the many, and he shall divide the **spoil** with the strong, **because** he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors.
