Jesus: The Founder and Foundation of the Church

(Study of Acts #1) Acts 1:1-11 Pastor Phil Winfield September 7, 2008

Matthew 16:18 And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.

Jesus gave provisions for us; His witnesses:

- 1. He gave us a **pattern** for the work (1:1)
 - a. Our behavior makes us **believable**
 - i. Titus 2:7, 8,10 ...in all things showing yourself to be a pattern of good works; in doctrine showing integrity, reverence, incorruptibility, ⁸ sound speech that cannot be condemned, that one who is an opponent may be ashamed, having nothing evil to say of you... ¹⁰ not pilfering, but showing all good fidelity, that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in all things.
 - ii. Matt 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.
- 2. He gave us a **promise** of a person (verse 5, 8)
 - a. Our dependence makes us dependable
 - *i.* John 14:16 *And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever—* ¹⁷ *the Spirit of truth...*
 - ii. John 15:26 "But when the Helper comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify of Me.
- 3. He gave us the **proof** that transforms us (verse 3, 9)
 - a. Our conviction makes us convincing
 - i. Luke 24:39 Behold My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself. Handle Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see I have."
 - ii. Acts 2:32This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses.
 - iii. Luke 24:50 And He led them out as far as Bethany, and He lifted up His hands and blessed them. ⁵¹Now it came to pass, while He blessed them, that He was parted from them and carried up into heaven.

Jesus gives encouragement to us; His witnesses

- 1. Don't worry: you have help (1:8)
 - a. John 14:26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.
 - **b.** His power makes it **possible**

- 2. Don't waiver: We have a task (1:6)
 - a. Acts 1:7 And He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority.
 - **b.** Our focus makes it **feasible**
- 3. Don't **wait**: we already have the Spirit
 - a. 1 Corinthians 12:13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to drink into one Spirit.
 - b. Titus 3:4-6 But when the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared, ⁵not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, ⁶ whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior.
 - c. Our waiting is a waste
- 4. Don't wait: He is coming back (Zachariah 14:4)
 - a. His coming is what compels us

Conclusion:

A witness is not a **prescription** of what you are to do; it is a **description** of who you are and whose you are. (Ye shall be **my** witnesses) Do you belong to Jesus? Is your life telling his story?
