

Wisdom to navigate difficult times is given to the:

I. Conflicted – "lack wisdom"

Wisdom comes to those who:

- **A. Realize** "If any of you "
- **B. Request** "ask of God"
- **C. Receive** "it shall be given"

II. Convinced Confident- "in faith"

Wisdom is given because God is:

A. Great – "nothing wavering" = no vacillating

B. Generous – "gives to all men liberally" Literally means = over and over again, purely and simply without bargaining.

Characteristic of divine giving ...as an example to our giving. Not because He has to or is somehow manipulated. No need for special words or formulas. No worry that God is a miser with His wisdom. No worry that God might hoard all His wisdom. No he dispenses His wisdom lavishly and joyfully.

C. Good – "upbraideth not"

God could really make fun of us...duh! We often are ignorant or downright stupid when it comes to things.

He does not chide us but instead takes pleasure and is eager to supply our deficiency.

III. Committed - "double minded" = double souled or inconsistent values.

Insincerity before God cannot be:

- **A.** Concealed " let not that man think"
- **B.** Controlled "unstable" i.e. a staggering drunk
- **C.** Contained "in all his ways"

Conclusion

- ➤ When we lack wisdom we can conclude:
 - We have not learned from our trials
 - We have not asked God for wisdom
 - We have not asked God for wisdom with faith.
