- The beginning of man's **environment** (1-2:3)
- The generations of man's **descendants** (2:4-chapter 50)

 - a. If God is not the creator then what was **he saying** in these verses?

 - c. If God did not make everything then can he **be trusted** at all?
 - d. If God is not the creator then what is the alternative? chance -

- 2. If God is the Creator... Then we have to take Him at His Word.
 - a. God created all that is. Verse 1.
 - b. First, God made **something** out of nothing 1:1 out of nothing (*ex nihilo*)
 - c. Second, God made the substance inhabitable 1:2-19
 - i. Day One: (v.1-5) materials, **light**, daily cycles and time.
 - ii. Day Two: (v.6-8) The division of heaven and earth, **space**.
 - iii. Day Three: (v.9-13) Dry Land, oceans, grass, plants **with seeds**, trees **with seeds**.
 - iv. Day Four: The **heavenly lights** especially where earth is concerned the Sun and the Moon. He made the stars also.
 - d. Third, God filled the habitat with **inhabitants** 1:20-31.
 - i. Day Five: (20-23) swarms of fish and sea creatures and myriads of **flocks** of flying things.
 - ii. Day Six: The last day God made creepy crawly things, herds and walking things and he created the **manager**, Man.
