Suffering is in the plan. 8:30 predestined → called → justified → glorified. Another link in the unbreakable chain = suffering, justification & glorification, where belongs! 8:17 includes the suffering of being changed on the inside, from carnality to Christ. 8:13 → You are putting to death the deeds of the body. You & the Spirit, mortifying parts of you.
8:18 encourages us: It is than worth it! All the pain in the universe cannot outweigh your first day in glory. The to be revealed will be all around us there, but glory will also be revealed us. We will be in a glorified state ~ pure reflectors of God. Whatever anguish we humans face, came to that before we did, and it was our fault! Our sin marred our image-bearing, subjecting the rest of the created order to futility, frustration, corruption, slavery, suffering ~ thus, Man and nature are in a struggle. But as a faithful remnant was "eagerly anticipating" the promised Messiah, so this creation is now on tiptoes craning to see the last of the of God brought into the Kingdom.
Paul challenges the: If all creation will not give up looking for its consummation and fulfillment, why should we?! Let us ~ in anxious longing, eager waiting, & hope of the revealing of that last son of God. We have to understand mysteries of grace, beautiful to cross the hills, loud mouths to herald the King's arrival. This plan includes a full rescue of the redeemed, and of the created order.  8:21. Creation will be associated with in our glorified state. But as creation groans now, we groan.  8:23 ~ We are, but fullness and reception are in future. We're already, but the body is corrupt and dying. Full consummation of being whole is in the future.
