PECA Sermon Outline on Romans 10:13-17, WLC 155, Sept. 7, 2014

Intro:

Last week, means of grace that effect your salvation. First focus, the WORD. READ WLC Q&A 155.

Main Point of Text: Paul says that the way people are saved is by hearing the public proclamation of God's Word.

<u>Sermon Point:</u> *Listen to your preacher.*

Move 1: The Spirit of Christ speaks salvation through His Word, especially preached.

- LC: "The <u>spirit of God</u> maketh the reading ... of the word ... an effectual means": Psalm 19:7 and Heb. 4:12 are so by the Holy Spirit; Effectual Calling (WLC 67). For elect, Word is Spirit's tool.
 - o Acts 16:14: Lord opened Lydia's heart to attend to things spoken by Paul, who spoke by the Spirit.
 - o And my speech and my preaching was ... in <u>demonstration of the Spirit</u> ...(1 Cor. 2:4).
- LC: "but especially the preaching of the word":
 - o Titus 1:3: hath ... manifested his word through preaching ...
 - o God uses the foolishness of preaching to save people: 1 Cor. 1:21

Move 2: The Spirit speaks through His Word to turn you inside out.

- LC "of enlightening, convincing, and humbling sinners": Neh. 8:8: So they [Ezra, priests] read in the book in the law of God distinctly, and gave the sense, and caused them to understand the reading. Vs. 9, the people wept. Vs. 10: told to rejoice in the strength of the Lord. They opened up.
- LC: "of driving them out of themselves":
 - o Luke 16:15. Remember, repentance is a "change of mind".
 - Acts 26:18: Jesus sent Paul, To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance ...
 - o Acts 2:37, 41: people pricked in their hearts by Peter's preaching asked how to be saved, and gladly responded to his instructions. They had crucified Jesus. Now they cried out to Him.
 - o Point of driving out of yourselves: LC "and drawing them unto Christ":

Move 3: The Spirit speaks through His Word to make you like Jesus.

- LC: "of conforming them to his image": Rom. 8:29a; 2 Cor. 3:18 such by the *Spirit of the Lord*.
- LC: "and subduing them to his will": preaching's function as God's weapon: ... to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ ... (2 Cor. 10:4-5)
- LC: "of strengthening them against temptations and corruptions": Now all these things happened

unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come. (1 Cor. 10:11)

Move 4: The Spirit speaks through the preaching of the Word to give you Jesus.

- LC: "of building them up in grace": And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance ... (Acts 20:32)
- LC: "and establishing their hearts in holiness and comfort through faith unto salvation." For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope. (Romans 15:4)
- LC: "but especially the preaching of the word" Rom. 10:13-17:
 - Concern: how can people be saved? By having faith in Christ. How? By hearing. Hearing what?
 God's Good News. How will they hear it? By the <u>preaching</u> of it: "proclamation/announce publicly"
 - o Vs. 13 quoting Joel 2:32 (Acts 2:21): ends with ... <u>as the LORD hath said</u>, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call. General outward call the means of the saving inner call.
 - o Vs. 15/16 quoting Isa. 52:7/Isa. 53:1: Suffering Servant saves by transfer. Good News changes bad.
 - o The main argument: Vss. 13-14, and 17
