- A. The Benefits of Finding Wisdom vs 13-18
  - 1. **Happiness** Pr 8:32,34-35 used 42 x's in the OT
    - a. Happy is the man who finds wisdom,
    - b. And the man who gains understanding;
  - 2. Benefits better than riches
    - a. For her proceeds are better than the profits of silver
      - i. proceeds profits the same word
      - ii. *cachar* profit (from trade):--merchandise.
    - b. And her gain than fine gold.
      - i. gain tabuw'ah income, produce:--fruit, gain, increase, revenue.
      - ii. Fine gold *charuwts* incised (*decoratively cut*) or (active) incisive; a trench (as dug), gold (as mined), a threshing-sledge (having sharp teeth); pointed things, sharp, threshing instrument, wall.
  - 3. Her Value Job 28:13; Pr 8:11, 19; 16; Mt 13:44
    - a. She is more precious than rubies,
    - b. And all the things you may desire cannot compare with her. Ps 19:9-10
  - 4. Stated benefits
    - a. Length of days is in her right hand, In her left hand riches and honor. Pr 8:18; 1Ti 4:8
    - b. Her ways are ways of pleasantness, And all her paths are peace. Mt 11:29-30 i. *no am* agreeableness, delight, suitableness, splendor or grace:--beauty,
      - pleasant(-ness).
      - ii. **shalowm** safe, peace, quietness of soul Ps 46:10
    - d. She is a tree of life to those who take hold of her, Jo 10:10 e. And **happy** are all who retain her.
  - e. And **happy** are all who reta
- B. Selling with Celebrities
  - 1. The Celebrity The Lord
  - 2. Look How He Did it Jer 31:35-37
    - a. By wisdom
    - b. By understanding
    - c. By His knowledge
- 3. Look What He did Ge 1:1,6-8,9,11,14,16,20,24,26; Ps 104:24; 136:5; Pr 8:27; Jer 10:12; 51:15; Heb 1:3
  - a. founded the earth;
  - b. He established the heavens;
  - c. the depths were broken up, Ge 7:11
  - d. And clouds drop down the dew.

    - a. let them not depart from your eyes

- i. *luwz* to turn aside, to depart, be perverse, froward, perverse(-ness).
- ii. Mt 6:22 "The lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light.

  - a. Personal life vs 22 So they will be
    - i. life to your soul
    - ii. And grace to your neck. Pr 1:9
  - b. Personal Activities vs 23-26
    - i. Your walk vs 23
      - safely in your way,
      - your foot will not stumble. Ps 37:24; Pr 10:9
    - ii. Rest When you lie down, vs 24; Ps 3:5; 4:8; Mt 11:29-30; Heb 4:9
      - you will not be afraid;
      - your sleep will be sweet
    - iii. Emotional Well-being
      - No Fear Ps 91:5; 112:7
        - -Do not be afraid of sudden terror
        - -Nor of trouble from the wicked when it comes
      - Confidence in the Lord
        - -For the LORD will be your confidence
        - -And will keep your foot from being caught.
- D. The Practical Outworking of Wisdom vs 27-32
  - 1. Toward your neighbor
    - a. Do Good- vs 27-28; Ro 13:8; Ga 6:10
      - i. Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, When it is in the power of your hand to do so.
      - ii. Do not say to your neighbor, "Go, and come back, And tomorrow I will give it," When you have it with you. Le 19:13; De 24:15
    - b. Don't Do Evil vs 29-30; Ro 12:18
      - i. Do not devise evil against your neighbor, For he dwells by you for safety's sake.
      - ii. Do not strive with a man without cause, If he has done you no harm.
  - 2. Having Mentors vs 31-35;
    - a. Envy corrupts vs 31-32a; Ps 73:3; Pr 24:1
      - i. Do not envy the oppressor,
      - ii. And choose none of his ways;
      - iii. For the perverse person is an abomination to the LORD,
    - b. God's Attitude Toward vs 32b-35
      - i. the Upright
        - But His secret counsel is with the upright. Ps 25:14
        - But He blesses the home of the just.
        - But gives grace to the humble.- Jas 4:6; 1Pe 5:5
        - The wise shall inherit glory
      - ii. the Wicked
        - The curse of the LORD is on the house of the wicked,
        - Surely He scorns the scornful,
        - But shame shall be the legacy of fools.
