What opens the gates of paradise?

Christ was righteous; are you?

Your obedience will not get you

What does the 'tent' refer to?

Who are those fit for communion with God?

What are characteristics that separate the righteous?

“In perfection this holiness is found only in the Man of Sorrows, but in a measure it is wrought in all his people by the Holy Spirit.” O Palmer Robertson

He Walks with integrity v 2

What does tammim mean?

He Works righteousness v 2

What does a righteous man do?

Speaks truth in his heart v 2

His word is his bond. You can take what he or she says to the bank.

He speaks truth, always. Even hard truth to honor God and help you.

He is self-aware, and therefore he is humble.

Does not slander v 3

He practices tongue control.

What is gossip again?

Does no evil to neighbor v 3

If your friend is in trouble, go to him; talk to him; help him; confront him; but do not add to his burden by repeating his possible faults publicly.

Rejects those God has rejected v 4

Choose your enemies well.

Don't make friends with the world; we make friends of God's people.

Honors those who honor the Lord v 4

How do you treat Christians who think and act differently than you?

Christians many times shoot our wounded.

Keeps his word even when it hurts v 4

Our word is our pledge

He does not oppress the poor v 5

He does not exploit the poor; he doesn't gain from their calamity.

He does not judge the innocent v 5

He does make money by selling justice.

Money- We must be willing to lose it (keep your word, even if it hurts)

We must be willing to lend it (not with painful interest.)

We must be unwilling to purchase. (Accept a bribe)
