Biblical Tools for Selecting a Spouse Part 4

From God's Side

- 1. The Bible is our most reliable source of information about what God wants for us
 - A. 2Pe 1:18 And this voice which came from heaven we heard, when we were with him in the holy mount. 2Pe 1:19 We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:

- B. Dreams, visions, signs, and wonders have been rare, and "concentrated"
 - I. Moses
 - II. Elijah
 - III. Jesus
 - IV. Each of these preceded the major portions of the writing of Scripture: in the Bible, signs and wonders always serve to validate the Word
- C. The Bible contains commands and prohibitions: things clearly to be obeyed
- D. The Bible contains precepts and wisdom
 - A. Proverbs 21.19
- E. So that the decision making process between marrying an unbeliever and someone who gets angry are vastly different processes

From our side

- 1. Seek to do God's will, focusing on the "big picture" of God's will first
 - A. It is God's will that people get married and have children so they can full the mission given to mankind.
 - B. It is God's will for people to glorify Him by loving their spouse, and raising their children, and I would argue that this is more important Biblically than "who." Remember, those commands about marriage are given to people who had little or no choice about their marriage.

- 2. Don't be hasty in making important decisions
 - A. Ecclesiastes 5.2
- 3. But neither be bound by fear
 - A. God is not going to tell you all that could happen
 - B. To refuse to act, out of fear, is to fail to trust the Lord
- 4. Do not assume that "God's will" will be evident by the lack of opposition and obstacles
 - A. I Corinthians 16.9
 - B. Philippians 1.12-13
 - C. I Thessalonians 2.18

- 5. Be careful (seek wisdom) about interpreting circumstances
 - A. Some are obvious: unbelievers, gender roles
 - B. Others are not.
 - C. The fact that things "pop-up" should not give them extra weight as "from God," since temptations also "pop-up." James 1
 - D. The reality is, that the only reason we're facing a decision is because of a circumstance
- Remember that every marriage partner is a sinner
