 - 3. Our physical world: Genesis 3.17-19
- D. And God promised salvation—through judgment. Genesis 3.15

The salvation of the creation

- A. Has never been simply about people going to Heaven, and escaping judgment
- B. It is about people being restored to the state of the original creation
- C. This is God's will from eternity past: Romans 8.18-29
- D. This is God's will for every believer at the end of their lives: I John 3.2
- E. This is God's will for us every day: II Corinthians 3.7-18

What does it mean to be like Christ?

- A. It means that it is God's will that we live our lives in human bodies, empowered by God's Holy Spirit—this is our existence
 - 1. The power of our Christianity is the Spirit: II Cor. 3.18
 - 2. The sufferings of our Christianity are part of this Christ likeness. Romans 8.16-18
 - 3. The outlook of our Christianity is part of this Christ likeness. Philippians 2.5-8

 - 2. John 6.38
 - 3. John 13.1-17
- C. It means that we are to like Him in our love
 - 1. Ephesians 5.2
- D. We are to be like Him in our purity
 - 1. Ephesians 5.2-15

- E. We are to be like Him in our endurance
 - 1. I Peter 2.21-25
 - 2. James 5.6-11
- F. We are to be like Him in our mission
 - 1. John 17.6-24
