Holiness

The Reason that God saved us

Last week

- 1. We learned that holiness matters to God
- 2. And that holiness is "separate-ness."
- 3. So our own, personal, separation matters to God
- 4. Because that is a major reason why God saved us

What we were prior to salvation

- Ephesians 2.1. We were spiritually dead to God in our trespasses and sins
- 2. And so worthy of God's wrath. Ephesians 2.3
- 3. This made us God's enemies. Romans 5.10

What God did for us at salvation

- 1. He gave us new life; resurrection life, in Jesus Christ. Ephesians 1.15-2.1
- He poured out His wrath on Christ, so that it wouldn't be poured out on us. Romans 3.25, I John 2.2; I John 4.10. Christ is the victim of God's wrath
- 3. Reconciled with us through the work of His Son. Colossians 1.19-22

Why did God do this for us?

- 1. To demonstrate His love. John 3.16
- To bring praise to His name. Ephesians 1.6;
 1.12
- 3. To prove His greatness to the angelic world. Ephesians 3.8-11
- 4. To recover us to a right standing in position and practice
