Luke 12:13-34

Do you wrestle with anxiety and worry and fear? Often these emotions come when we treasure the Creator’s gift above the Creator himself. Today Jesus challenges us to grow in faith (v 28) and trust (v 31) that our Father in heaven knows our needs. He gently reasons with us “about your life” (v 22), challenging us to reshape our priorities around the Father’s eternal kingdom. Rest in his sovereignty and grace. Imitate his merciful kingdom work!
