? Do you practice self-examination and self-confrontation?

Self-Examination Careful examination of your own behavior and beliefs to see whether they are good or bad

Self-Confrontation Confronting sin in your life to confess and repent of it

Psalm 139:23, 24 Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me and know my anxious thoughts; And see if there be any hurtful way in me, And lead me in the everlasting way.

Often there was a specific reason for such introspection.

Laments: 2 Kings 20:1-6; Psalm 130; Psalm 32:3-5; Psalm 6

Protective Psalms: Psalm 7, 17, 25, etc.

This psalm is not a lament or protective psalm.

We know this because of the structure.
