Spring Branch Academy – Page 3 **Theology** Language The **motto** of our school points to this reality: Tutors should review the following: Wisdom and worship are in a circle. **Education** = **Arts** and **Sciences** Worship leads to wisdom: (skill) (knowledge) "The fear of the LORD is the beginning..." (things we *do*) (things we *know*) **Liberal Arts** = Trivium + Quadrivium Wisdom leads to worship: Psalm 104 – We study creation and praise God! The liberal arts are *classical* education. Sum: There is no education without God. Trivium *Grammar* – skill in speaking → sentence Logic – skill in reasoning \rightarrow argument The Book of Job (Job 28, 38-41) Wisdom is ultimately the "big reason" for things. *Rhetoric* – skill in persuading → speech Wisdom comes from God's mouth alone (Pr. 2:6). To gain wisdom, we need **Revelation** from God. The Three "Rs" of Traditional Education **Reading** – Christianity alone gives us true History *Writing* – like the Trivium (verbal arts) **Three Ways God Reveals Himself** *'Rithmetic* – like the Quadrivium (math arts) Through His **Works** – created things (Rom. 1:19-20). Through His **Words** – written Scripture (2 Tim. 3:16). **Note:** We are showing that classical education lacks Through His **Word** – Jesus, His message (Jn. 1:1-18). the reading component (is it a "science", not an "art"?). We are also taking advantage of that difference to stress that classical education needs the Bible. Note: The tutor may display simply the three words. Scripture Proverb The tutor asks the question and students respond. 

Two Realms of Space and Beyond

Invisible – not seen Visible - seen

According to Paul, the *seen* realm is temporary, but the *unseen* realm is eternal (2 Cor. 4:18).

Two Realms of Time and Beyond



BC = before Christ

AD = anno domini (Lat. "in the year of our Lord")

The Bible has two large sections:

OT – Old Testament, written largely in Hebrew NT – New Testament, written wholly in Greek

Contrary to the Greeks and Eastern religions, which assume that history is cyclical (pendulum), God's revelation teaches us that history is *linear*, which means it has a beginning and an end.

History

The Bible history timeline can be chanted or sung. This is just the start of a multi-verse poem.

Who are Adam and Eve?

Beyond being the *first man* and the *first woman*, Adam and Eve are the first marriage (Gen. 2:18ff), which establishes a transcultural pattern (2:24).

As a mystery now made known (Eph. 5:31-32), marriage also represents *Christ* and the *church*. As Eve was made from the body of Adam, so the church is made from the body of Christ.

Adam and Eve were also the first sinners:

Eve sinned first (1 Tim. 2:14), but affected no one. Adam sinned willfully and condemned everyone. Adam is the covenant head and represents everyone. (See Rom. 5:12ff and 1 Cor. 15:20-22, 42-49.)

In this way, Adam is a *type* (or pattern) of Christ. Just as the one act of the one man condemned all, so the one act of the one man justifies all in Christ.
