Matthew 18:1-14

- I. THE QUESTION OF VALUE (18:1)
 - A. Am I Important? —to God, to others
 - B. How Do I Rank?—compared to others
 - C. What Does Heaven Value?—Different cultures value different things.
 - 1. Humility is Beautiful to God (Isa 66:2)
 - 2. Humility is Necessary for Salvation (Rom 3:10; Eph 2:8; Jas 4:6; 1 Pet 5:5)
- II. THE IMPORTANCE OF CHILDREN (18:2-3)
 - A. The Definition of Little Ones ()—literal children, those who are weak, all Christians
 - B. The Concern of God—Protector of the weak, Defender of widows, Father of orphans
 - **1. Don't Despise Children.** (10; Lev 19:13-14, 29, 32-34; 1 Cor 1:26-29) Don't show contempt, look down on, dislike or undervalue the weak.
 - 2. Don't Mislead Children. (6) Don't use your power to deceive, use or abuse.
 - **3.** Do <u>Receive</u> Children. (5)—welcome, associate with, care for

- III. THE IMPORTANCE OF INDIVIDUALS (18:12-14)—the Shepherd seeks one lost sheep God is personal and relational.
 - A. He Notices that one sheep is missing. He is watchful.
 - B. <u>He Knows each sheep by name.</u> (Jn 10:3)—He relates to you individually, not merely as part of the herd.
 - C. <u>He Pursues each stray.</u> He takes action. He goes after the stray. Each soul is precious to God.
 - D. He Rejoices over each restoration. He doesn't shame or punish; He celebrates!
- **IV.** THE IMPORTANCE OF HOLINESS (7-9)
 - A. Temptations Are Inevitable.
 - B. Individuals Are Responsible.
 - 1. For <u>Ourselves</u> (Mat 7:5; Ps 4:4 and 139:23-24)—Take drastic measures to cut sin out of your own life.
 - 2. For Others (Rom 14:21; 1 Cor 8:13)—Don't cause others to stumble.
 - a. our <u>example</u>/witness
 - b. our influence
 - c. our <u>authority</u> (Ezek 34)
 - C. <u>Sin Is Deadly Serious.</u> (Jn 14:15; Eph 5:6; Gal 5:19:2; Heb 12:14; 1 Jn 3:9)—It caused the death of Jesus on the cross.
 - 1. Hell is real.
 - 2. Judgment is coming.
 - 3. Jesus paid the ultimate price to redeem us.
