The Two-Penny Widow

Lk 20:45-21:4 (Mk 12:38-44); Mat 6:1-8

- **I. THE SCRIBE** (Lk 20:46-47)
 - A. <u>Seeking Attention</u> (1 Sam 16:7)—from men (not God)
 - B. Enjoying Respect (Jn 5:44; James 2:1-4)—expect partiality
 - C. Exploiting Position (Lk 20:47)—
 - 1. Greedy
 - 2. Abusive (take advantage of the vulnerable)
 - D. Pretending Righteousness (Lk 20:47)—
 - 1. Pretentious Prayers (Mat 6:5-7)
 - 2. Ostentatious Offerings (Mat 6:2-4)
- **II.** THE WIDOW (Lk 21:1-4)
 - A. Overlooked (Isa 53:2)—not worthy of notice
 - **B.** <u>Undervalued</u> (Isa 53:3)—she is very poor; not a threat to avoid or a benefactor to ingratiate
 - **C.** <u>Easily Exploited</u> (Mk 7:11-12)—lacks legal representative to defend her

D. Generous and Sincere—gives out of her poverty, without seeking attention or expecting accolades

III. THE LORD

- A. <u>THE ONE WHO WATCHES</u> (Gen 16:13; 29:32)—Jesus the People-Watcher; "The God Who Sees Me"
 - 1. <u>He watches people</u>. Active Interest in People
 - a. Divine Omniscience is not distant or disinterested.
 - b. Jesus doesn't just know things; He watches people!
 - **2.** <u>He notices widows</u>. (Deut 10:18; Ps 68:5; Isa 1:17; Js 1:27)
 - a. Jesus notices people that no one else pays attention to.
 - b. Jesus values people that others think are insignificant.
 - 3. He observes worship. (Rev 1:10-11)
- **B.** THE ONE WHO COUNTS (Lk 20:47; 21:3-4; 2 Cor 8:12)— The worth of the gift (Ps 50:9-12)
 - 1. He knows the Situation. (21:4)—considers what you have, not what you don't have
 - **2.** <u>He knows the Motivation</u>. (Jn 4:23-24; 2 Cor 9:7; —the sincerity of worship
 - **3.** <u>He is the Judge</u>. (Lk 20:47b; Mat 6:2, 5)—what pleases God
