Answer: *Key Verse:* **Jeremiah 5:22** says, "Fear ye not me? saith the LORD: will ye not tremble at my presence, which have placed the sand for the bound of the sea by a perpetual decree, that it cannot pass it: and though the waves thereof toss themselves, yet can they not prevail; though they roar, yet can they not pass over it? " Explanation: God has promised in His Word that the boundaries of the lands are set perpetually. There may be some natural shoreline erosion, and an occasional flood in some places, but the boundaries are firm.
