Cf. Gal 6:7; Pro 11:24-26. An agricultural axiom. Sparingly=in a limited way; minimal contribution. Bountifully=on the basis of	
blessings; praising and thanking God B. THE RULE OF LIBERTY	7
Freely giving is the foundational biblical principle for giving. After careful reflection; accompanied by conviction of correctness,	
contentment in offering. Recall 2 Cor 8:3-4, 11. Not with or out of emotional pain, sorrow; grudgingly, forced to conform to external pressure. Cheerful giver= from LXX of Pro 22:8a; <i>bless</i> changed to <i>love.</i> Joyful, settled satisfaction and contentment in heart.	
Opposite to reluctant and compulsion.	
C. THE RULE OF SUFFICIENCY	8-9
Its Scope– note the <i>alls.</i> The God's grace is in excess of man's needs, Rom 5:15, 20, pre-eminently shown by Christ on his cross. Eph 1:7; 2:7; Rom 2:4 with Tit 1:13-14; 1 Pe 5:10; etc. God causes the superabundance of his grace to overflow to those who give biblically.	
Its Service– his bounty results in our saying, participating in satisfying others' needs	
Its Substantiation– from Ps 112:3-9; 111:3-5. Divine attributes applied to generous Christians. A biblical model of giving; God's own righteous provision as the foundation for the righteous man to be generous.
